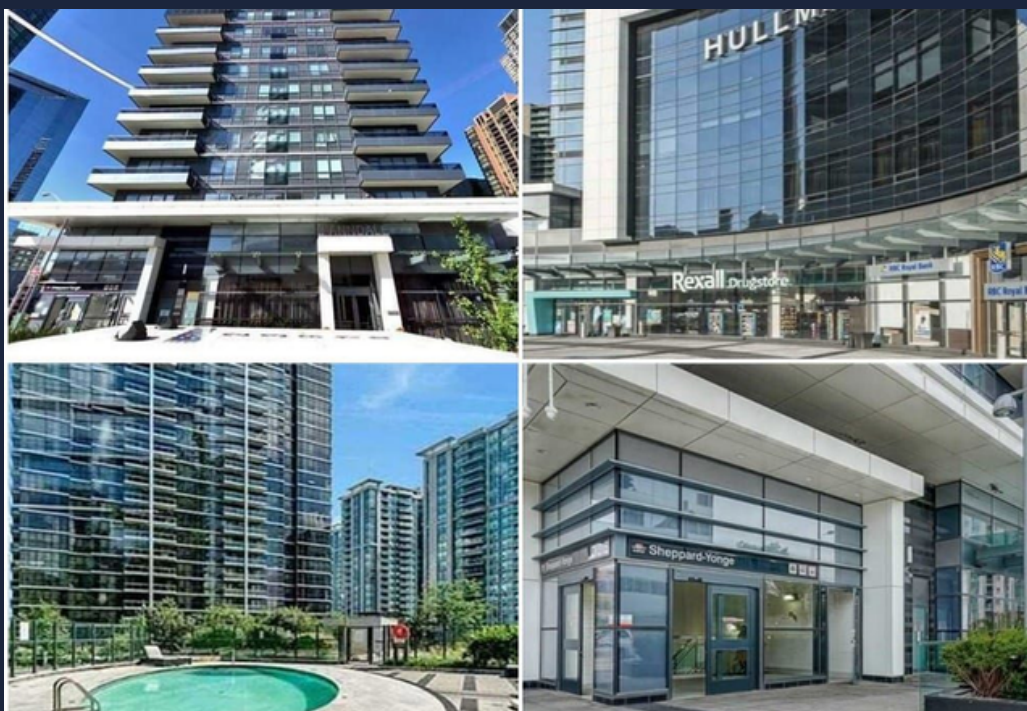
HUMAN RESOURCE DEPARTMENT

Please be advised that if you book your vaccination and/or booster shot, you will be required to present us with proof of vaccination and/or booster shot in order for us to ensure you get a paid sick day. Any emails pertaining to this should be sent directly to h@pillarsecurity.net.

This program enables everyone who is employed under the Employment Standards Act (All Pillar Staff), to have a maximum of three paid COVID-19 related sick days.
